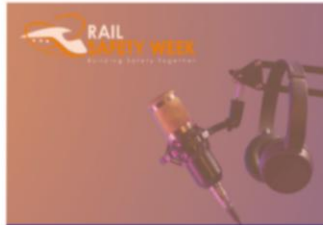

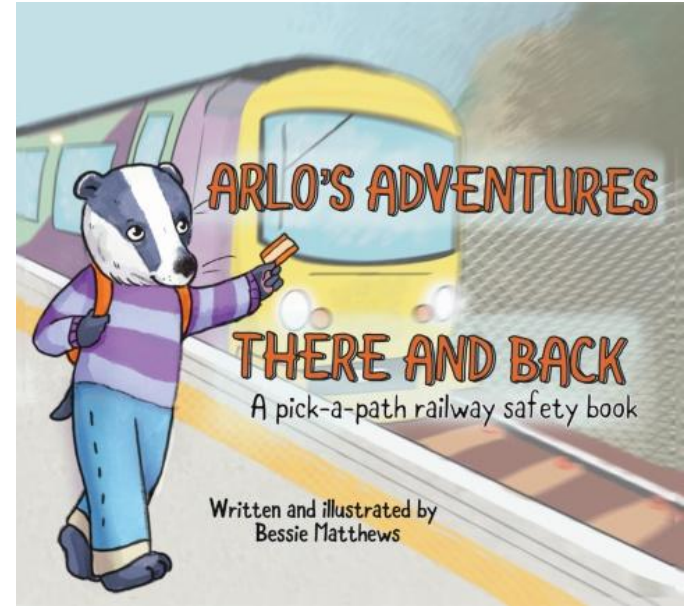

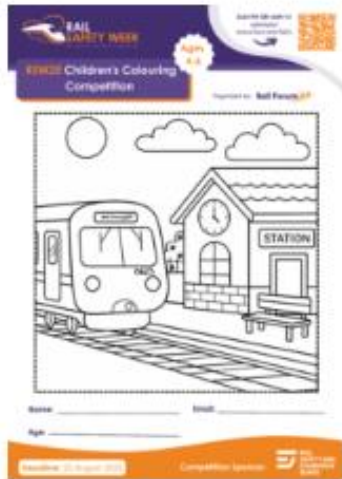

Colouring Competition Ages 4-6



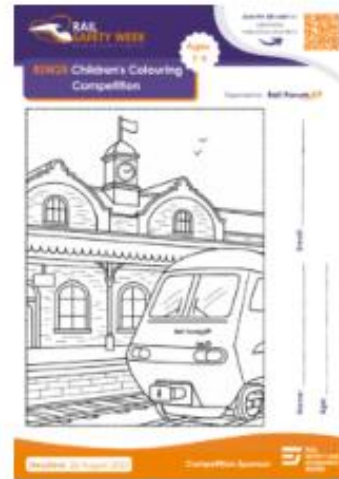
Age 4 Winner
